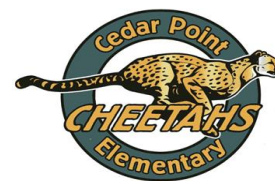
2020 production of Disney's Little Mermaid

## Kindergarten Registration Dates

Registration dates for Kindergarten will be on  
Thursdays, April 2, and April 16, 2020. Your  
child must be five years old on or before  
September 30, 2020 to enroll in kindergarten
